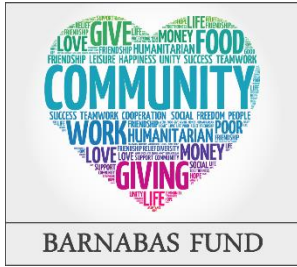


THE BARNABAS FUND

The Fund seeks to encourage the ministry of congregations through a grant-based ministry investment strategy that seeks Kingdom-based ministry results through shared resources, fiscal accountability, ministry planning, and economic partnering.

BARNABAS FUND RECIPIENTS

- Consideration will be given to congregations whose characteristics include:
 - A verifiable active outreach ministry
 - Located in and serving a community with a significant economically challenged population
 - Limited resources with circumstances beyond their control
 - Sizeable community needs that surpass the congregation’s ability to respond.

There must be clear evidence of Gospel and Mission.

- The Barnabas Fund shall not be used to:
 - Compensate for poor stewardship practices
 - To compensate for deferred maintenance
 - Sustain an “inwardly” focused congregation seeking survival.
